- * A good CB or VHF Radio with an external antenna
VHF frequencies are: 151.625, 154.540, 151.715, 151.745, 151.815, 151.900, 151.925, 162.550 (weather)
- * First Aid Kit
- * Fire extinguisher
- * Flashlight
- * Tire Deflators - or other provisions to deflate tires
- * Compressor - or other provisions to inflate tires
- * A jack kit and all tools necessary to change a tire.
- * Spare tire
- * A recovery strap with two 3/4" clevises - no metal hooks
- * Drinking water - 1 gallon per person per day is recommended
- * Food/Snacks - No lunches provided

TRAIL RULES (We support Tread Lightly guidelines and all state driving laws)

- * Do not consume any alcohol before or during the trail rides. Do not use any drugs that might affect your ability to drive safely.
- * Wear seat belts when vehicle is in motion.
- * Drivers should **always** set the parking brake before exiting the vehicle
- * Stay on established trails.
- * No littering. You are encouraged to pick up refuse left by others.
- * All vehicles must be street legal, registered and insured.
- * All vehicle safety equipment must be functional
- * All participants are required to sign a Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement and provide proof of vehicle insurance.
- * All operators must be licensed and at least 18 years of age.
