### Trail difficulty Ratings:

#### **A note about trail ratings**

Trail ratings are subjective, and should be for general guidance only. The trail staff has a great deal of experience leading drivers of all skill levels in all types of Hummer vehicles over these trails. We've taken many first-time drivers on very difficult trails with excellent results: very little damage and very happy drivers. Regardless of skill level, if a driver listens and follows trail staff instructions well, he or she will have no problem with any of the trails we're offering.

#### **Easy and/or scenic**

Easy trails will have very few, if any, obstacles and very little risk of mechanical breakage or body damage.

#### **Difficult**

Difficult trails will have many obstacles, some of them quite challenging. There is a moderate likelihood that one or more trucks on the trail will require mechanical attention. Body damage is unlikely, but there will be situations where rocker panel protection contacts obstacles. Trail staff will be spotting participants on all of the difficult obstacles on these trails.

### PARTICIPANT AFFIDAVIT:

**Complete and mail to Marc Balocco with registration,** You must have the required equipment and have done the mandatory vehicle preparation. **No vehicles allowed on trails without completed affidavits.**

### **Event fees:**
