

Participant Affidavit to The Hummer Club, Inc.

Complete and bring to event on-site registration

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

- First Aid Kit
- Fire extinguisher
- A jack kit and all tools necessary to change a tire.
- Spare tire
- A recovery strap with two ¾" clevis - no metal hooks
- Drinking water - 1 gallon per person per day is recommended
- A good CB Radio with an external antenna

TRAIL RULES

The Hummer Club, Inc. strongly supports Tread Lightly guidelines and all state driving laws.

- Do not consume any alcohol before or during the trail rides. Do not use any drugs that might affect your ability to drive safely.
- Wear seat belts when vehicle is in motion.
- Drivers should always set the parking brake before exiting the vehicle
- Stay on established trails.
- No littering. You are encouraged to pick up refuse left by others.
- All vehicles must be street legal, registered and insured.
- All vehicle safety equipment must be functional
- All participants are required to sign The Hummer Club Release, Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement and provide proof of vehicle insurance.
- All operators must be licensed and at least 18 years of age.

MANDATORY VEHICLE PREPARATION

Your vehicle must be well-maintained and in good running condition to participate in the trail rides. Do a complete mechanical inspection and perform the necessary repairs prior to the event.

Factory and/or dealer mechanical support is provided for the express purpose of making sure that everyone is able to keep the vehicle on the trail and drive the vehicle home. The supporting dealer technicians will do other non-essential work if time permits and they alone will set the priority on each request for repairs. The Club expects that attendees will do their regular maintenance prior to any event.

You or your dealer must certify that the following inspections have been made: Please mark each item that has been inspected. This list was originally made for the H1 and most items will also apply to the H2 & H3.

- Caliper mounting bracket bolts
- Half shaft bolts
- Differential output flange nuts and the input yoke nut
- Brake pads
- Driveshaft U-joint clamp bolts
- Ball joints & fasteners
- Tie Rods
- Pitman arm
- Idler arm
- Steering gear box mounting bolts
- All fluid levels
- Look for fluid leaks
- Engine belt and hose condition
- Tires for wear & tear
- Lug nuts for proper torque
- Winch operation
- Lights
