

Event Checklist

Before coming to the event:

Register for the event (Obviously)

Hotel Reservation

Trip Planning - Three primary things you should gear up for are:

- Safety and Survival
- Vehicle Recovery
- Vehicle Breakage

Vehicle Check

Check engine oil

Check transmission oil

Check brake fluid

Check radiator coolant

Check windshield wiper fluid

Check fan / serpentine belts

Check coolant hoses

Check air cleaner

Check fuel lines

Check steering (Pitman arm/Idler Arm)

Check Tie Rods

Check tire air pressure (air up to recommended pressure for highway driving, air down at trail head, air up prior to trip home)

Check for tire wear or damage

Tighten drive shaft U-bolts

Check and tighten lug bolts

Check for frame cracks

Check brake pads & shoes (adequate braking pad material, in good condition and without contamination)

Check for loose bolts or nuts throughout vehicle

Check gear oils: transfer case/differentials, replace if necessary

Check Winch for proper operation, check winch cable for kinks, frays or damage

Check suspension and shocks

Grease all fittings (u-joints, steering)

Remove any steps or nerf bars

Items to Bring to the event:

Required Equipment

Full Tank of Fuel (Each day)

3" or 4" wide tow strap (No built in Hooks) – 20' or longer

Two (2) or more D-Ring Shackles for tow strap (5/8" or 3/4")

First aid kit

Fire extinguisher

CB Radio or Walkie-Talkie (need to stay in touch on the trail)

Food, snacks and Water (1 Gal/person)

Spare Tire (Full Size)

Working tire jack & Lug Wrench
Tire Air Pressure Gauge

Recommended Equipment

Any Medications you may require (Allergies??)
Trash Bags (Keep the trails clean)
Insect Repellent
Snake Bit Kit
Toilet Paper
Paper Towels

Flashlight
Spare Key
Good Boots
Rain Gear
Sunscreen
Bottle/Can Opener
Pocket Knife
Hat
Leather gloves
Extra clothing (in case you get wet)
Small cooler (for sandwiches and drinks)

Hi Lift Jack - 48"

Engine Fluids (Brake, Oil, ATF, Water)
Spare Fan / serpentine belts
Spare coolant hoses

Spare Tie Rod
Spare Half Shaft
Spare Pitman/Idler Arm
Duct Tape
Jumper Cables
Matches/Lighter
Tarp (to keep yourself out of the mud)
Work coveralls
Bungee Cords
Ax/Saw
Chain saw (with fuel and oil for it)
Electrical Tape
Zip Ties
Various Tools for repairs
